Annual Report 2022-23

It is a privilege to present the Annual Report of **Saroop Rani Government College for Women** for the academic session 2022-23.

Ninety one years ago in 1932, this college started its journey with a handful of 50 girls as Stratford Intermediate College in a small rented building. It was raised to degree level in 1938 and to PG level in 1971. Today, with about 2800+ girl students on its rolls, the college enjoys the rare distinction of being the only government college in the region for girls and also one of the model colleges of Punjab. Our premier institution, conferred with 'A' grade in Cycle-II of NAAC assessment, is committed to inculcate moral and ethical values in our students and empower them to become strong and competent citizens of society.

It gives me immense pride and satisfaction to apprise you that this academic year has been exceptionally eventful. We have successfully strived to maintain our glorious tradition in the pursuit of excellence. We have tried to realize our goals through various activities and innovations. The session 2022-23 commenced with the successful admission of 2873 students to UG and PG programs through Centralized Online Admission Portal – a digital initiative of the Govt. of Punjab.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE COLLEGE

• The college has 15 programs running successfully in the college which include 09 undergraduate programs in Humanities, Commerce, Science and Computer Science, 05 Postgraduate Degree Programs and 01 Postgraduate Skill Based Diploma. The Postgraduate Degree of M.Com Business Innovations has been introduced from this academic year only into our bouquet of courses. We also offer skill based Certificate Courses in English, Commerce and IT under JGND PSOU. The students can pursue these courses along with their regular programs to make them more competent to meet the demands of global scenario.

- Highly dedicated and diligent faculty of the college comprising 28 regular, 10 part time, 49 guest faculty teachers(PTA & HEIS) and 09 visiting professors, including 27 Ph.D.'s, 20 M.Phil's and 06 gold medalists work tirelessly to ensure high academic standards and global competence in the students under the able guidance of the Principal Prof. Dr. Daljit Kaur.
- Our sprawling, spacious and **eco-friendly** campus with around 400+ trees, well maintained lawns, Botanical gardens and grounds impart an idyllic and conducive environment for the holistic growth and development of the students.
- We are pioneers in the entire state of Punjab to have a **Geo Park**, a unique geo-morphological treasure of its own kind in the entire Punjab region.
- To enrich the learning experience of students and staff of the college, we have a well-stocked computerized central library with a comprehensive collection of **56743 books** and subscription to **09 newspapers**, **37 magazines and journals**. In addition to this, the **N-List program of INFLIBNET** provides a facility to access the E-Resources also. It has a separate visual section to facilitate audio visual teaching process, provides reprographic facility for educational needs and also extends Book Bank facility to the needy students.
- To facilitate the academic and co-academic activities, we have **19 well-furnished classrooms**, **14 ICT enabled classrooms**, an academic block and **27** well-equipped Science, Geography, Psychology, Computer and Language labs.
- The campus has Student Center cum Canteen, Water Coolers, Basketball Court, Gymnasiums, Volleyball Court, Multimedia Room, Auditorium, Bookstall, Photostat Outlet, surveillance mechanism and ramp for differently-abled students.
- College Hostel, equipped with all amenities, has an accommodation for more than 200 students at a subsidized fee structure for the benefit of girls from rural areas. It aims to facilitate their accessibility to the college and ensure their security.

Excellence in academics, sports, co-curricular and infrastructure has been possible due to the constant support of the State Government, Centre Government, Director Higher Education, RUSA, MHRD and GNDU, in providing us with funding and other appropriate facilities.

Grants

Grants received from State and Centre are utilized to enhance the teachinglearning process and give the institute much required facelift.

This year, the institution received the Equity grant of Rs.93,750 & Infrastructure Grant of Rs. 50 lacs under RUSA, Grant of Rs. 2 lacs from State Govt. under Office Services, Viveki grant of Rs. 7,50,000 & Rs. 1,12,50,000 under HE-24, which has been utilized to make new additions to infrastructure, IT and sports facilities for the welfare of students.

In addition to this, the college has been granted the Administrative approval of Rs. 3 Crore 1 lakh 80 thousand under *HE-24 for Provision of Infrastructure Facilities* in Govt. Colleges.

A) INFRASTRUCTURE: Construction and Up-gradation

- Construction of **Seven new rooms in the College Hostel** to meet the demand of students.
- Refurbishment of Girls Hostel, Home Science Laboratories and Staff washrooms.
- Construction of Lift is underway which shall make the infrastructure specially-abled friendly.

B) EQUIPMENT (RUSA Grant)

- **E-Podiums and IFP's** have been purchased for digital classrooms.
- o New desktop computers are installed in Computer labs.
- Augmentation of Sports Equipment which will benefit the students in the practice and fitness.

C) Green Initiatives

The college adopted green protocol under green campus campaign. Sustainable utilization of natural resources, well managed waste management system and planting of trees are the major concerns of the campaign to make campus environment friendly.

- A Social Entrepreneurship, Swacchta and Rural Engagement Cell (SES-RC) was incepted in the college to inculcate and internalize the values of Mentoring, Social responsibility, Swacchta and care for environment and resources in faculty, students and community.
 - Around 120+ new trees were planted in the campus under Van Mahotsava.
 - Self help groups of students are formed, who are working as brandambassadors for establishing sustainable community. Awareness Drives were organized in Majhvind-Gopalpur, the village adopted under Green campaign.

This session has been a continuous saga of success with distinguished achievements in academics, sports and co-curricular activities.
